
## Holy 45 Martyrs of Nicopolis



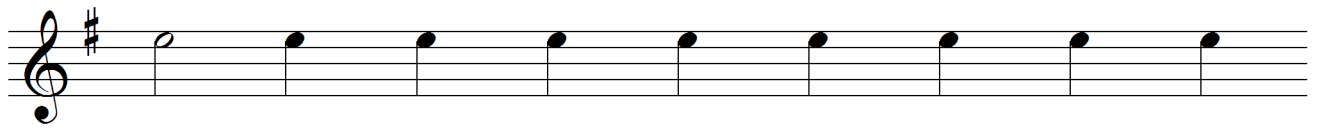
